Call for interviews of pre-selected applicants to the Scholarships under Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at the University of Rwanda for Academic Year 2024

The University of Rwanda in partnership with Mastercard Foundation is implementing a 10-year Scholars Program (August 2021- June 2031) aimed at enabling higher education access for 1,200 young Africans qualified, but with limited access to opportunities and/ or from conflict and post-conflict affected areas. The program focuses on women pursuing Sciences, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM), young people with disabilities (YWD), and refugees and displaced youth.

Following the call for application for 165 scholarships available in the academic year 2024, the program is pleased to invite the 382 pre-selected applicants for interviews scheduled with effect from 3rd to 7th July, 2024, to take place on its 5 Campuses (Nyarugenge, Gikondo, Huye, Rukara and Busogo) in accordance to the schedule below:
